In Berlin we will join about 30 gerontology students from over 20 EU nations to hear presentations and participate in work groups. All students and faculty speak English. Presentations are also in English. You will develop a multi-cultural appreciation of issues that will affect you, your family and your future, and meet new contacts for future travel, education and work opportunities. Excursions include visits to facilities for older persons and may include the Berlin Wall, Brandenburg Gate, Spree River sightseeing cruise, Reichstag (German Parliament), and Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp.
