Program centered around DRUPA, the largest printing media, publishing, and converting exhibition in the world. It is held every four years in Dusseldorf, Germany at the Messe Dusseldorf. Exhibitors covered 39.88 acres of space and 393,654 people attended DRUPA in 2004. Messe Dusseldorf reports DRUPA 2008 will break all of its previous records. With some 170,000 sq. m. of net exhibition space and exhibitor numbers topping 1,800, this will be the biggest DRUPA ever in its more than 50-year history. Program will include industry tours, university experiences and historical hands-on experimental learning opportunities for students interested in the print media, publishing & converting industry in multiple cities in Germany. Program includes an excursion to Paris, France to see the calligraphy exhibit at the Louvre & other historically significant sites.
