This course will provide students with the opportunity to learn about grassroots efforts to improve the living conditions, educational opportunities, and economic well-being of women and children in Uganda. Students will be exploring Ugandan life, history and culture through films, lectures, and classroom activities. The course will culminate in a 3-week trip to Uganda. Students will live in accommodations provided by a grassroots Ugandan NGO and will participate in community development activities. Students will choose to work with 1 of 4 projects: baby cottage, schools, economic development, or health education. During the weekends, students will be engaged in side excursions to the source of the Nile and Queen Elizabeth National Park.
